

Criminal Justice, Associate of Science (AS)

Description

Working to complement and build upon Criminal Justice diploma level classes offered residentially at select Lincoln Group of Schools campuses, the Criminal Justice online degree completion program is designed to prepare students with a strong foundation upon which to build a successful career. **Graduates of this program will earn an Associate of Science (AS) degree and will possess necessary knowledge and skills to enter the criminal justice and private security profession.**

The overall educational objective of the program is to provide students with the opportunity to gain the understanding required to work in the private or industrial security and loss prevention industries. Coursework is intended to introduce students to various aspects of the criminal justice system, prepare students to

work in a multicultural society and emphasize the importance of ethics in the workplace.* The Associate degree portion of the program in particular is designed to develop students' strength in areas pertaining to their personal and professional development, resulting in a well-rounded education.

Upon completion of the Associate of Science degree in Criminal Justice, graduates will be equipped to confidently pursue employment in areas such as loss prevention, private security and protection services, government agencies and law enforcement and more. **Graduates also have the option of continuing their studies at Lincoln College Online to earn a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice and the Study of the Criminal Mind.**
